Admittance Policies

The Runnymede Swim Club will follow the City of Toronto Aquatics Admittance Policies. Please note the following caregiver supervision and change room requirements. More information regarding pool use policy information on site.

Change Room Use:

Children 7 years of age and older are required to use the change room designated for their gender.

Admittance Policy (based on age and swimming ability):

- Children 6 years of age or younger must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or designate who is at least 14 years of age and is responsible for their direct supervision and must be within arms reach (2:1 child:caregiver ratio.)
- Children 7-9 years of age must pass a facility swim test in order to be admitted without caregiver supervision.
- Children 7-9 years of age who cannot pass the facility swim test must remain in the shallow end and be accompanied by a parent, guardian or designate who is at least 14 years of age and is responsible for their direct supervision (4:1 child:caregiver ratio.)
- Children 10 years of age or older may enter the pool unaccompanied but must pass a facility swim test before accessing the deep end of the pool.
